

DIRECTIONS FOR GOF DRIVE FEBRUARY 7, 2020

We will be driving through some of the most beautiful, historic roads in Citrus County. PLEASE be careful to observe the posted speed limits! Local law enforcement tends to be very protective of their territories, and speeding tickets are a major source of their revenue.

Start at entrance to Plantation Resort; set odometer to 0.0

LEFT on Fort Island Trail

0.4 RIGHT on US 19/Suncoast Blvd

1.7 LEFT on Venable Rd (which becomes Crystal Oaks), ends at Hwy 44;
turn right

12.2 Right on S. Lecanto Hwy (CR 491)

20.0 Left on Stage Coach Road (CR480)

25.6 Left on Pleasant Grove

25.7 Immediate Right back on to Stage Coach Trail (CR480)

29.9 Left on S Florida Ave (Hwy 41)

31.2 Right on East Orange Ave. (This is historic Floral City; the beautiful oaks that line the road were planted by the townspeople in 1883).

NOW PAY ATTENTION!

35.6 Left on Trail's End (CR39A), the next left after the boat ramp. Don't miss it!

38.8 Left on Withlapopka (CR39A) at the T intersection

42.8 Right on E Gobbler – stay to the left

47.0 Right on S Florida Ave. (Hwy 41) it will become Hwy 44. In about 4.7 miles, Hwy 41 turns off to the right. Stay on Hwy 44 toward Crystal River.

60.8 Left on Rock Crusher. Stop light and BP station.

62.0 Right on Venable (stop light)

64.5 Left on US Hwy 19 (stop light)

65.1 Right on Ozello Trail (stop light)

74.1 Arrive at Peck's Old Port Cove on the right. Park the cars tight; additional parking in the rear.

After lunch, to return to the Plantation:

Ozello Trail back to US 19. Turn left, and proceed 0.8 miles to the 3rd light (Fort Island Trail) Turn left, and the Plantation is on the right in 0.4 miles.

For ethanol free gas, drive an additional 0.3 miles to the PURE station on the right.
